

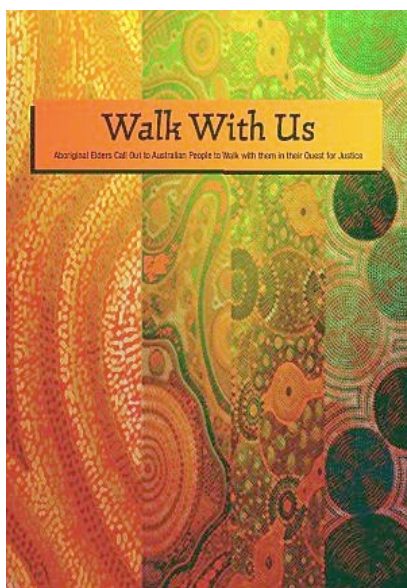
“Walk With Us”

Beautifully illustrated, this hard-covered book provides a very important update of the current thinking about the Intervention. Following her visit to meet with Aboriginal elders in Darwin, Navi Pillay, the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights expressed her own concerns.
